LAUGHLIN OUTREACH

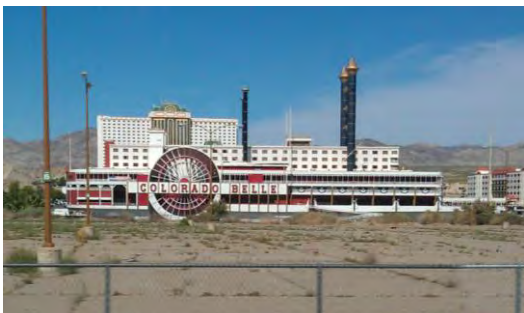

April 26 – May 2, 2011 in Nevada. The first Chariots of Light Laughlin River Run Outreach has been completed, but won't be our last! So much excitement among the COL TEAM that participated. COL had a 10 x 10 tent space set up in the Colorado Belle Hotel & Casino parking lot – one of many venues along the Casino Strip there in Laughlin. We had 27 Chariots of Light shining brightly in the gambling, partying, drinking rally during the River Run. All but two of our COL were from out of state and the two from Nevada were from Las Vegas. The other states represented were: California (20), Kansas (1), Arizona (2), and North Carolina (2). Pastors Juan & Kathy Juarez came from Delano, CA and Pastors Joshua & Iliana Bulger came from Visalia, CA. We had 3 other Chariots, besides ourselves, that stayed the entire time of the rally. All the others stayed for 3 days, 2 days, or just 1 day, but were a blessing and helped to make a difference in so many lives! We were able to share the Word of God with over 620 people and 152 made Decisions for Christ! Glory to God! Hallelujah!

We met each morning before the tent opened, to pray together and for a time of preparation and instruction. We didn't have a local Laughlin church contact for us to meet at the church, so we improvised and met outside of the hotel at 8:30 a.m. along the broad sidewalk area of the river walk. One morning, a local lady stopped and listened in for a long time before she continued on her exercise walk.

All the COL involved were very receptive to instruction as we shared from previous outreach experiences and were very willing to share God's love and be a light! The Name of Jesus was exalted in Laughlin, Nevada! We believe an impression was made at that outreach for the glory of God!

REV then led group in COL monthly Bible study and meeting was concluded *with prayer for Dr Savelle & Col Leadership!*

On Saturday, April 2nd, I was polishing the Rocket in my driveway. I had went to get gas in her, and wash her. However, I had only grabbed a twenty. Usually a twenty will get a tank of gas, and leave change to wash the scooter, and get a coke. But do to the price of gas, when I filled her up, I only had a buck left. So, I dropped the quarters in the car wash and did a quick run-a-round the bike, soaping and rinsing her real quicky, running home before she dried all the way to wipe her down.

As I was in the driveway, a man, which I would guess was 50ish, came down the street on one of those little motorized chairs. As he saw me wiping down my red chromed beauty, he pulled in to my drive way.

We introduced ourselves and began to talk about motoreycles. He commented that mine looked fast and it was obvious that, although he was in a wheelchair, he didn't need prayer for healing on his eyes. He then asked me how much mine had cost to which I told him how it was a gift from a great man of God. He asked me if I went to church and I told him how I was a traveling evangelist, and that God lets me ride all over the world telling people about Jesus.

As we talked, I knew where this was going, as I began to hear Holy Spirit whisper in my ear. I began to 'sneak' questions into our conversation, slowly and subtly bringing the conversation to 'spiritual things'. Just as I was taught by Dave Malkin back sometime ago before I was in Chariots, and had volunteered to help at a Thunder Over Texas rally.

What really surprised me, was as I began to minister to him, I found myself going back to questions that I had used on the Daytona outreach. Questions that were on the survey, and questions on the 'Gospel Soul Winning Script' that Bill had given each of us.

I should explain, that these methods were really hard for me when I went to Daytona. They were difficult because they were different to the way I had 'gotten used' to doing

things. They were different from the way I had learned from Bro. Malkin, they were different from things I had seen other people do in street ministry, and they were WAY different from ministering behind the comfort of a pulpit! LOL!

Bill had even asked me if I liked or disliked the materials, because of the obvious difficulty I was having in using them. To which I responded that it was not a question of like or dislike, but me just getting used to them. However, like Paul, I was determined to be a "wise master builder" and add this tool of ministry to my belt. So for 9 days, the full time at Daytona, I worked on incorporating the survey and the script into the way that I ministered to people.

Now, here I was, three weeks later, in my driveway ministering to this man and Holy Spirit was bringing every thing I had practiced in Daytona to do it.

Kirby, this mans name, **didn't** know that God loved him and had a wonderful plan for his life. Kirby **didn't** know beyond a shadow of doubt, that if he was to die, he would go to heaven.

So, I immediately went to the Word. He had heard "for all have sinned and come short of the glory of God. He had heard "for the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." He had heard "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

And then the big question!! "Kirby..." I asked. "Do you realize that you are the *whosoever* that verse is talking about?"

Then it happened. Just like the end of Billy Rex's fishing pole when it bends. I knew we had him. I saw the change in his face. I saw the revelation in his eyes. I saw the presence of God touch this mans heart. He realized this man was being born again! Hallelujah!

I asked him if he would like to 'call upon the Lord' right then and there, to which he said "Yes!" and we prayed. Kirby asked Jesus into his heart. Kirby asked Jesus to forgive him of his sins, to wash him, cleanse him and set him free. Kirby confessed believing that Jesus was crucified, died, raised, and was Lord. He confessed being saved, born again, and on his way to heaven.

Before he left, I ask him again. "Kirby, if you were to die today do you know beyond a shadow of a doubt if you'd go to heaven?"

"I'd go to heaven." he said.

People are so precious, and it was such a blessing to minister to this man. I realize this is probably more than you wanted, Bill and Ginger, but it was a really cool afternoon, just polishing my ROCKET. He has seen me minister to people from pulpit, but I like when he sees me minister in streets. It lets him know that this just isn't what dad does for a living, and that I serve a real God who loves people.

 <p>The Cherohala Skyway</p>	<p>There are many rides that I feel are great and compete for the position of my favorite ride... (Just to be able to ride again will be great.) I seem to be a long haul kind of guy. I really enjoy the rides we had out to Texas. Whether it was to Thunder Over Texas at the Speedway or to The Thunder Over Texas in Granbury. I really enjoy the real road trips. But I think that my favorite ride would have to be in Tennessee as we travel from here at home up to the Cherohala Skyway! This highway connects Western North Carolina to Eastern Tennessee. You travel the crest of the Unicoi Mountains. I love to travel from Robbinsville, NC. to Tellico Plains in Tennessee. There is one part of the trip that you are at an elevation of approximately 5,390 ft. There are numerous curves along this stretch of highway. Some are quick and sharp, but the ones that I like are the long sweeping curves that you can look off the mountain and see for miles and still be able to ride relaxed. I have seen all kinds of wild life along this trip and no matter what time of the year you might still need a jacket as you cross the mountains. Most of all it is about 60 miles of uninterrupted motorcycling with an almost continuous view. Add in some Chariots of Light riders as company on the journey and you have my favorite ride. After the surgery I have to spend the first 10 days on a walker. (Mine has been modified slightly with motorcycle helmet stickers and drag specialty emblems.) then I have to spend 10 days on a cane. Then after 6 weeks I am pretty much given clearance from my Doctor to begin to really move freely and bend like I'm supposed to. As I write this article it has been 4 weeks and 4 days and I must Give God the praise. The Surgeons can do all they know how to do...but God is still my healer. I am getting stronger every day and making it into the gym 2 or 3 times a week to work these legs. Getting ready for the next surgery. (Really I'm getting ready for riding season! You know it's true!) I am looking forward to the day when I have no more pain from my hips rubbing bone-on-bone. I have one that is already pain free and it won't be long until the other one is completed also. Remember to keep me and my family in your prayers during this process. Yes, it is still a process. Especially keep Sherri in your prayers as she seems to be the one who really has to help me the most. (It is a humbling thing when you can't even put on your own shoes and socks.) But I am getting there. We appreciate ALL THE SUPPORT, both spiritual, physical and financial. You all have been so amazing. I am so honored to be a member of Chariots of Light.
