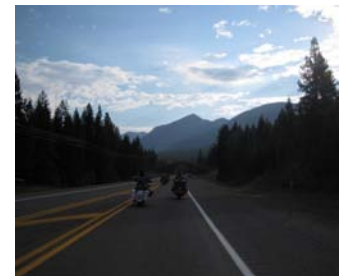

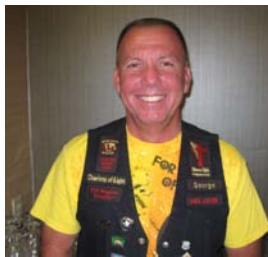


# COL CHAPTER NEWS - SOUTHWEST

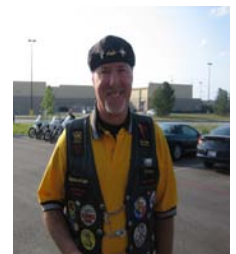
