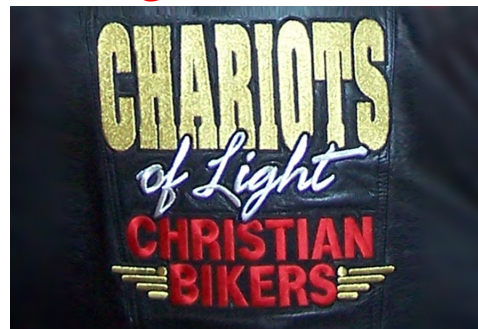

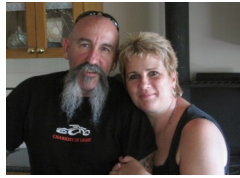

Melbourne Chapter

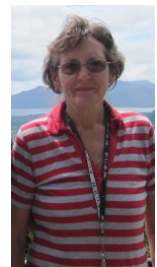

About three years ago (2007) I was diagnosed with type 2 diabetes. I was put on metformine three times a day. I was very upset but I continued to fight it off and on by watching what I was eating. Several times it went above 33 which can put you into a diabetic coma. In 2009, my sugar spiked again to over 33 and this time it was not coming down. I was told that I would have to start taking insulin and I was devastated. I was questioning God and my faith. I asked God why he was not healing me. Was I not doing something that I was supposed to do or was there sin in my life that I did not realize that was there. I continued questioning things and even talked to my pastor about it. Because we believe in healing and so I was continually looking for answers

believing for my full healing of diabetes.

Then, this year, on the COL Canada Tour in May, God opened doors for me to go. What a blessing! Then at the service in Waterloo, Dr. Jerry Savelle prayed over me for healing of diabetes. He also told us that if we need healing to pray for someone that needs the same healing and one of my brothers, Scott, and I prayed for each other.

So that night, I get back to our hotel room at around 11:30 p.m. just after eating a big meal and I checked my blood sugar and it was perfect at around 5.7. Normal is 4.5—7. Then the next morning, I checked it again and it was still around the same as the night before. All I could do was praise God and thank Him! For the rest of the tour week, I continually checked it and it stayed normal.

Still to this day, I no longer require any insulin or other medication! God has given me complete restoration from diabetes! Amen!!! Praise God!

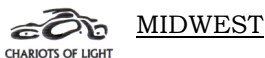

Also, our group in Bethel, has purchased a motorcycle for a missionary in Asia!! Praise God!



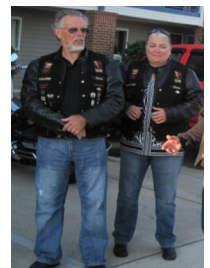

the restaurant and started preaching on Holy Spirit infilling and all 6 of them were baptized in the Holy Spirit and spoke in tongues! Praise the Lord !



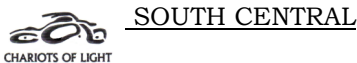

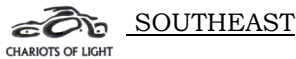

Potato Festival, Mule Days and the Fyffe UFO Days. Also in 2010, we had the most new members to join within our chapter than in any other year.

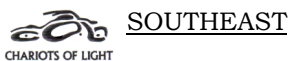

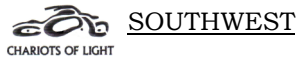
## COL CHAPTER NEWS - SOUTHWEST
