The year of accountability. Let's look closer at some aspects of that.

The number 21 can also be a symbol of perfection, and maturity, divine wisdom, mirror of eternal light, which pierces and penetrates all grace in its purity. This is great grace at its best if you live in the kingdom.

What kingdom are we a part of? The age of 21 is a time when the world sees a time of maturity. You come of age to do what you want legally and it's alright to do it and ok to be that way. Friends, don't get me wrong: By no means do I count myself an expert in all of this, but I've got my eye on the goal, where God is beckoning us onward—to Jesus. I'm off and running, and I'm not turning back. 15-16 So let's keep focused on that goal, those of us who want everything God has for us. If any of you have something else in mind, something less than total commitment, God will clear your blurred vision—you'll see it yet! Now that we're on the right track, let's stay on it.

Let's keep our focus on the goal, the high calling; working together as a body of believers for the purpose of eternal life. Don't look at the circumstances, what's around you or behind you. Keep your focus up and on the highest calling to know Him intimately. He's the ultimate goal for us and each other, then others! The gift we have been given to know Him and be able to share this eternal life of love with others. The power that comes from your relationship with Him, will cause power to be given to others. The strength of your relationship will be the strength to reach others.

We must yield to Him total commitment; have an all-in attitude with heart passion, He's our bodily fashion we fashion ourselves after! We are the body of Christ. This is what we're were created for, such a time as this. We are of those who move what we see. Not moved by what we see. Faith cometh by hearing The Word; not fear from what we've heard.
